Environmental Policy

1. General Policy Statement

The Management of Euro liners regard the promotion of environmental practices and policies as an essential objective for employees at all levels.

It is the company's intention to take all reasonable measures to prevent damage to the environment. The Policy extends to all contractors and suppliers in so far as they may affect the environment through their activities and the services they provide to the company.

The company realises and recognises that a successful environmental management system contributes to improving business performance by reducing waste and energy consumption, protecting the environment and reducing the risk of litigation.

2. Objectives

In pursuance and in full compliance with all relevant legislation, the company also realises and recognises that environmental objectives are an integral and important part of the management system and is therefore committed to:

- 2.1 Pursuing progressive improvements in environmental performance through recognising that legal requirements define the minimum level of achievement.
- 2.2 Providing a workplace that is, through effective controls, without risk of pollution to the environment.
- 2.3 Maintaining effective system of communication on environmental matters.
- 2.4 Maintaining effective employee participation and co-operation through regular meetings.
- 2.5 Supporting the Policy through the provision of adequate financial, human and physical resources.
- 2.6 Providing any necessary expert advice and assistance in respect of environmental matters.
- 2.7 Ensuring the competence of all employees and contractors in respect of environmental matters associated with their work activities.
- 2.8 Ensuring compliance with the requirements of the Euro liners Environmental Policy.

3. Application of the Policy

The Policy shall apply to all employees within Euro liners.

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4. Responsibility

The responsibility for determining the Euro liners Policy rests with the Proprietor. He together with management are responsible for :

- 4.1 Planning and regularly monitoring and reviewing the Policy.
- 4.2 Developing the Policy and operating procedures.
- 4.3 Regularly assessing the company's environmental performance.
- 4.4 Communicating the Policy.
- 4.5 Ensuring compliance with the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and all other relevant legislation.

5. Employee Duties

- 5.1 The company expects all employees to be aware of the environmental aspects of their work activities and to take reasonable care to ensure that they do not adversely affect the environment.
- 5.2 Employees shall co-operate with any policies and procedures developed and implemented in the interest of the environment.
- 5.3 Employees shall co-operate with the company in its efforts to ensure compliance with legal obligations.
